## Tekniker renews its agreement with Bureau Veritas to maintain its main Oil Condition Monitoring laboratory in Eibar

• The French multinational has renewed the collaboration agreement it has had with Tekniker since 2018, when it acquired the technology centre's industrial oil analysis laboratory

"Knowing the status of both the oil and the equipment is becoming more and more important in industrial environments in order to avoid, in a proactive manner, possible failure due to inadequate lubrication and to diagnose the status of equipment through the analysis of the lubricant in use. Tekniker's know-how in this field has allowed us to offer quality services and to develop new solutions," adds Adolfo Malaga, OCM Director of Bureau Veritas.
